Bulletin 2017-3 Safety

Reference Modified Lite STARS Rules dated October 16, 2016

30 SAFETY EQUIPMENT

1. Fire bottle system HIGHLY recommended must be fastened down with metal spring bands and not plastic. SFI 17.1
2. Fire resistant driving suit required. Single layer minimum SFI 3,2a1 or double layer SFI 3.2a5
3. Fireproof gloves required. SFI 3.3/1 or 3.3/5.
4. Fireproof shoes required. SFI 3.3
5. Full-face helmet required. SA 2010, SA 2015 SFI 38.1, FIA 8860-2004, FIA 8860-2010, Snell 2005, Snell 2010, SAH 2010, or SFI 31.1/2005 .
6. Head and neck restraint systems recommended SFI 3.38.1
7. Driving racing harness & restraints required. SFI 16.1 Replacement 2 years, Restraint Assemblies for youth drivers SFI 16.2
8. Full Containment Seat recommended. SFI 39.2
9. The following are recommended:
 - a. Window nets SFI 27.1
 - b. Arm restraints SFI 3.3
 - c. Head & neck restraints SFI 3.38.1
 - d. Neck collars SFI 3.3
