



## Bilstein Modified Lite STARS Announces Mod Lite STARS 600cc Futures Cup

Somerset, PA (January 15, 2015): Bilstein Modified Lite STARS President of Racing Operations Bill Bauer is pleased to announce the forming of the Mod Lite STARS 600cc Futures Cup. Bauer stated “that it’s a request we’ve had from several of our race teams, and starting a 600cc program is a perfect fit for our younger drivers”. Starting in 2015 season Roaring Knob Motorsports Complex owner Rich Jones has agreed to add the 600cc Futures Cup to Roaring Knob schedule on a bi-weekly schedule with all drivers entering to race receiving a free pit pass competing for trophies and special awards. Bauer will be talking with Bridgeport Speedway to establish a miniseries between the two speedways.

Roaring Knob Motorsports Complex is located near Markleysburg PA just off of scenic Route 40 on Fearer Road, 7 miles east of Nemaocolin Woodlands on the right, 1 mile west of Yough Lake on the left. Roaring Knob has ample areas inside the facility for lawn chair viewing, or you can sit in our grandstands, or come early to reserve a drive-in parking spot and view from your car. Drive-in parking is on a first-come, first-served basis.



Just recently Bauer announced the addition of Bridgeport Speedway to the STARS program. Brian Ramey CEO of the speedway will be placing the mod lites on the Fast and Furious Friday Night schedule for April 10<sup>th</sup>, June 26<sup>th</sup>, August 14<sup>th</sup>, and October 2<sup>nd</sup>. October 23 and October 24<sup>th</sup> will mark the inaugural two-day show for the Bilstein Mod Lite STARS East Cost Nationals.



Since January of 2004 Bridgeport current owners, Brian Ramey and Jay James, have made a constant effort to provide race fans with a state-of-the-art racing atmosphere. Renovation and expansion continues to this day and the speedway is the only thing that has remained the same since Ramey and James gained control.
