

Alan Knepper Wins Lernerville Stampede and Captures Bilstein Mod Lite STARS Mid-Atlantic Championship

Salisbury, PA (October 27, 2013): Alan Knepper scored a prestigious win in the STARS Modified Lite portion of the fifth annual Steel City Stampede. Knepper earned \$500 for the victory, and he received the trademark belt buckle trophy. The event was hosted at Lernerville Speedway.

Jeff Teeter jumped out to an early lead over Tracey Fritter and Brian Woodhull. Fritter spun on lap seven, while giving chase to the high-flying Teeter. On the double file restart, Woodhull got the advantage, and assumed the lead. However, Lynn Knepper surged ahead one lap later. Meanwhile, Knepper's son, Alan, was also moving ahead. He was racing in the third spot when another caution slowed the pace.



Alan Knepper got a terrific start when racing resumed. He hugged the inside line through turns one and two and took the lead away from his father coming off the second corner. Soon thereafter, Lynn Knepper spun on the backstretch while racing second. He did a complete 360, and got his car restarted, falling back to ninth in the process.

While the second generation driver maintained control the rest of the way, he had to withstand two green-white-checker finishes, which had the net effect of extending the race to 17 laps. Alan Knepper was up to the task and he rode home with the win.

Fritter raced his way back to second. Woodhull crossed in third, but was disqualified when he pitted without going across the scales. That moved Braeden Dellinger up a notch in the final results. Lynn Knepper was given credit for fourth, with Tyler Frankenberry getting fifth.
