

Crutchfield Win's 1st Annual NC Prelude Winter Classic Presented by nXs Motorsports

Veteran driver Jamie Crutchfield return to the track and once again demonstrated why he was a dominated driver when he ran the mod lite /DWARF car circuit in his younger years. Now a family man, Jamie, the son of well known mod lite engine builder and founder of Crutchfield Performance/Leader Chassis, Eddie Crutchfield, traveled from their home town of Chickamanga, GA to race in the 1st Annual North Carolina Prelude to the Winter Classic presented by nXs Motorsports at "The ROCK of HOKE" Rockfish Motorsports Speedway.

After winning his heat and running straight up, Crutchfield had the ideal starting spot sitting on the pole driving his Leader Chassie #51 for the 20-lap \$500 to win feature. At the start Jamie was able to get the lead on lap 1 and was able to hold off Hanoverton, OH driver Chris Logan driving his nXs sponsored #21, and Florida STARS Regional Champion driver Bo Bass #41B. Caution flew for the #32J of Jake Layton who lost the handle in turn 1&2 which allowed the field to tighten up. At the green flag restart, Crutchfield once again took charge and picking up the checker flag earning an automatic qualified position for the 2nd Annual Bilstein Mod Lite STARS Winter Nationals at Bubba Raceway Park.



Excitement continues to build in the Fayetteville/Raeford, North Carolina area with the formation of the Carolina Mod Lite Club. The club was formed by local driver/owner Duke Layton. The club will focus on building the Mod Lite division in the area with the help of Modified Lite STARS affiliation.
