

Hay Wins Roaring Knob Big Kahuna Bilstein Mod Lite STARS Topless Challenge

Markleysburg, PA ([September 29, 2013](#)): Mikey Hay had a near perfect weekend at Roaring Knob Motorsports Complex during the Big Kahuna weekend. The driver from Somerset, PA was unstoppable, sweeping his heat, the dash, a King of the Hill race, and [Saturday's](#) A Main event taking home a cool \$1000. The only time that he did not finish first was in time trials.

This program marked the first time that the series ever raced without the tops on the cars. The drivers were unsure what to expect, but all acquitted themselves well.

In the final round of [Friday's](#) King of the Hill event, Hay squared off against Tracey Fritter, the evening's fastest qualifier. Fritter got the jump, and took the preferred line at the top entering turn one. Hay turned in under him and powered off the bottom of turn two with the lead. Fritter remained close, and charged into turn three on the second and final lap. But, Fritter's car broke loose, causing him to spin as Hay swept under the checkers.

Hay had an easier time of things on [Saturday](#) in the A Main. He got out to the lead at the drop of the green. Regional point's leader Alan Knepper ran a close second, and it looked as though two of Hay's Evolution chassis cars would battle to the finish. It was not to be, as a broken spindle sidelined Knepper midway through the race.

Fritter came through the pack to grab second in the finale. Tim White ran a consistent race, taking third. Brian Woohull and Braeden Dellinger placed fourth and fifth. Matthew Hay, Mitch Ward, Darin Gallagher, Matt Cain, and Troy Gum completed the top ten.

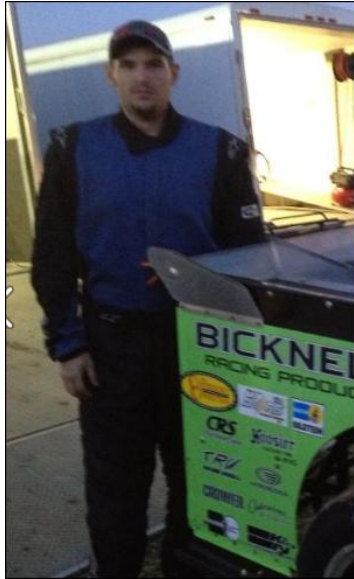
The heat winners were Mikey Hay, Tim White, and Fritter. Fritter was also the fastest qualifier for the event. Mikey Hay won the dash.
