

Bilstein Modified Lite STARS Set Record with 335 Races Scheduled for 2014

Bill Bauer President of Racing Operation announced last week that the Bilstein Modified Lite STARS have exceeded all expectations for the 2014 season setting an impressive 335 weekly and regional races scheduled for the 2014 season. During our annual meeting with our sponsors at PRI back in December, sponsors wanted more information concerning car counts, tracks and events schedule. Using information provided by the clubs presidents and regional reps we were able to develop a list of all the STARS tracks and scheduled events.

We just completed our first full month of racing and have fifteen winners among the 30 races scheduled. Mother Nature was our top winner with fifteen events rained out, top regional winner was the driver of the #110 Kenny Batterbee who took home a cool \$1000 for his feature win at Texana Raceway Park. Weekly big shot winner for the month of April will be handed to Valley Speedway feature winner #46 Dillon Raffurty for his four feature wins.
