## BILSTEIN MODIFIED LITE STARS GREAT LAKES & MID ATLANTIC REGIONS TEAM FOR BUCKEYE SPRING SHOWDOWN

SOMERSET, PA: The much anticipated Buckeye Spring Showdown took place this weekend in the Buckeye state with the first stop at Limaland Motorsports Complex, the home track for the University of Northwestern Ohio (UNOH) known for their College of Applied Technologies. The ¼ mile high bank clay NASCAR sanction track located in the heart of Lima, Ohio know for their “Class A” operation did not disappoint the 25 Mod Lite STARS that was signed in for night one of the Spring Showdown.

### Friday Night May 12th Limaland Motorsports Park



After 2 consecutive rainouts, the sun finally shined down on Limaland Motorsports Park to welcome the fans for Modified Mayhem presented by K&N Filters. The STARS Mod Lites invaded Limaland for the first time with New Matamoras Ohio’s Tyler Riggs picking up the win in the No. 99T. No. 95J “Jedi” Jerry Bowersock would grab the win in the K&N Filters UMP DirtCar Modified feature as part of the Whelen NASCAR All American Series, and No. 34S Gregg DeTray of Swanton Ohio would grab the win in the Bud Thunderstock feature.

In feature action, the STARS Mod Lites would kick off the night with a wild feature that saw great battles throughout the field. No 22 Will Bennett and No. 16 Rod Jones led ther field to green with Bennett spinning on lap 2 to bring out the first caution. No. 8M Mark Marcucci would lead until lap 6, when Tyuler Riggs would begin his assault on the leader. Riggs would take the point and never look back. Marcucci would finish second but was disqualified after failing post race inspection, giving 2nd to Rod Jones. 3rd was No. 59 Tracy Fritter, 4th No. 16S Keith Smith, and No. 1C Doug Stanley completed the top 5.

## Saturday Night May 13<sup>th</sup> Waynesfield Raceway Park

Night two of the first annual Buckeye Spring Showdown saw Mother Nature at its best with cloudless blue skies and temperatures in the low 70's. Twenty three Mod Lite STARS were signed into the pits preparing to battle the high bank 3/8<sup>th</sup> mile oval.

With starting lineup based on heat results saw Deerfield, Ohio standout driver Kenny Meadows starting on the pole driving the #16J owned by Keith Smith. The twin car #16 piloted by Smith started in the second position which challenged the Waynesfield scoring officials throughout the 20-lap feature.

At the green flag Meadows got a good start and was able to get the lead on lap-1. The first caution of the night flew on lap-6 for the spinning of the #56 of Ross Sanders. With the field tighten up saw a battle between #16J Meadows, #99T Tyler Riggs, #1C Doug Stanley, #20S Brandon Shaw and the #16S Keith Smith putting on a show for the top five spots. On lap-11 the #55 Ross Sanders lost the handle coming out of turn 4 bringing out the

second caution of the night. At the restart Meadows got the jump with #99T of Riggs hot on the tail of Meadows. Unfortunate on lap-12 Riggs had a mechanical failure coming off of turn 2 ending Riggs night. With Riggs now heading to the pits, the #1C of Doug Stanley powered around race leader Meadows taking the lead on lap-12, but only to see Meadows return the favor on lap-14. Now with Meadows in the lead, and Stanly receiving pressure from third place runner #224 Shayne Meadows, Stanley took on the high banks of Waynesfield and carried the speed out of turn 4 getting around Meadows on lap-15. Meadows in second had one shot at the Larry Coan Champ Chassie #1C but Stanly was able to hold off the #16J picking up the \$500 win along with the two day \$125 points pay day.
