The 2nd Annual Bilstein Mod Lite STARS Winter Nationals kicked off Wednesday February 17th at Bubba Raceway Park with the Lightning Racing Chassis Early Bird registration and inspection. Forty teams from twelve states took to the road and headed south with hopes of taking home more than \$20,000 in cash for a three day nationals.

First up on Wednesday night and with nearly perfect weather gave the Mod Lite STARS drivers three hours of hot laps to dial their 1000cc powered mod lites around the 3/8th mile oval. Carrollton, Ohio, Brandon Shaw driving the #20 set fast time of the night with a 17.160,

78.671 mph. Second fast went to West Monroe, NY driver Joe Isabell #6J with a 17.220 and third to Tyler Riggs #99T 17.270, but on Friday night during his heat race, Andy Sherly driving the Andy Snow Plow Check #95 set a mod lite track record with a 17.050 and then during the feature race, Warren, Ohio driver Jeff Teeters driving his Leeder #23 broke the record with a 16.873 lap. .

Thursday, February 18th the STARS were on the track for the 20-lap Superior Race Cars Triple 5 paying \$555 to the win and \$200 to start. Laurel, DE, Jimmy Hill driving his #1 started on the pole and was able to get the jump on the field to lead every lap of the 20-lap feature. Red flag flew on lap-3 when the nXs #21 of Rod Jones took a wild flip in turn 2. Jones was unhurt but ended his night.

Once again Hill was able to get a good start off of turn-4 followed by the #3 of Jeremy Isabell, and the #6J of Joe Isabell. At the cross flags half way signal Hill in the lead, a battle for second between the two Isabell's along with the #99 of Josh May who had started in the 16th position was taking place.. With a few laps remaining the last caution flew for the spinning of the #20 of Brandon Shaw that tightens the field. Hill maintained his consisted lap speed winning and taking home the \$555.

Friday, February 19th Night Two of the Bilstein Mod Lite STARS Winter Nationals saw Warren, OH driver Jeff Teeters take the lead on lap-11 and winning 20-lap nXs Motorsports Triple 5 paying \$555 to win.



The green flag flew for the 20-lap feature with 2015 Florida Sunbelt regional STARS champion Bo Bass in his #41B on the pole. Bass took the lead and was able to lead the first two laps when caution flew for an incident in turn four. On the restart the #6J of Joe Isabell was able to get around Bass coming out of turn two and was able to maintain the lead through lap-10 when caution flew for the spinning #13T Jason Dye. On the restart Isabell had the advantage with the single file restart but within two laps

Teeters made the pass out of turn two for the lead. Teeters who broke the track record with a 16.873 lap was able to hold off Isabell and winning Night 2.
